<b>Collaborative</b>	V4P staff, Board, and members work collaboratively with each other and with allies at other donor collaboratives, grassroots organizations, political entities, lawmakers, candidates, and more. We value and incorporate a variety of perspectives.
<b>Informed</b>	V4P strives to continually inform its efforts with the latest information, data, and context.
<b>Intersectional</b>	V4P members have economic privilege and often other forms of privilege as well. With this in mind, V4P looks to intersecting communities most directly impacted for which concerns and solutions to advocate for. V4P recognizes the interrelatedness of the policy issues we focus on (e.g. economic and racial inequality is often related to lack of access to clean air, water, and green space).
<b>Mission-Driven</b>	V4P members, staff, and Board are dedicated to advancing V4P's values and mission, striving to embody them in our approach to all of our work.
<b>Strategic</b>	Voices for Progress is outcomes-driven and focuses on policy and political efforts in which V4P's grassroots advocacy model can have a tangible impact either in the short-or-long term.
